

Clare Rae challenges conceptions of space in *Light Weight*.

Clare Rae's photographs always make me more aware of my mass - in terms of how I occupy space. (Why do I sit or stand in a certain way?) Her previous works have used photography and video to heighten this awareness by introducing subtle absurdities and impossibilities. In The Chase she pursued herself in infinite circles; in Climbing the Walls and Other Actions she subverted "normal" room use. In Light Weight, Rae extends her collusion with the medium - freezing herself midjump. These are double suspensions: Rae in space, the photographs in time.
